The Open Science principles at CZU cover topics such as:

Research data management: Promoting research data management throughout the research data life cycle by data management plan (DMP) and FAIR Principles (whenever possible, research data must be Findable, Accessible, Interoperable and Reusable).

Open Access: Promoting free online access to scientific information, such as publications and data.

Encouraging the unconditional right to reuse research outputs, modify them, and reshare them.

Open Science also stands for recognising and appreciating of other issues such as educational activities, citizen science activities, leadership qualities, and social impact.
