

Determination of the Tuition Fee for Studies in a Foreign Language at the Faculty of Engineering for the Academic Year 2025/2026

Article 1 Introductory Provisions

- (1) This Dean's directive applies to the Faculty of Engineering (hereinafter referred to as the "faculty") of the Czech University of Life Sciences in Prague (hereinafter referred to as "CZU") and sets the tuition fee for studies in a foreign language for the academic year 2025/2026.
- (2) This directive is issued in accordance with Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions, as amended (hereinafter referred to as the "Act") and Article 25 of the Statute of the Czech University of Life Sciences in Prague (hereinafter referred to as the "Statute").

Article 2 Determination of the Tuition Fee for Studies in a Foreign Language

(1) The amount of the tuition fee for studies in a study program/field conducted in a foreign language according to Section 58(4) of the Act (hereinafter referred to as the "tuition fee for studies in a foreign language") is determined as follows:

Master's Study Programs	500 EUR (13.000 CZK)
Doctoral Study Programs	500 EUR (13.000 CZK)

Type of Study Program	Amount of the Fee in EUR (CZK) per Academic Year for Applicants from Non-EU Member States
Bachelor's Study Programs	1.000 EUR (26.000 CZK)
Master's Study Programs	1.000 EUR (26.000 CZK)
Doctoral Study Programs	1.000 EUR (26.000 CZK)

- (2) The decision on determining the tuition fee for studies in a foreign language according to paragraph 1 of this Article is issued by the Dean or a Vice-Dean authorized by the Dean. The fee must be paid before the enrolment in studies or before enrolment in a higher year of study.
- (3) The Dean or an authorized Vice-Dean may reduce the amount of the tuition fee to the level valid for the academic year in which the student was first enrolled. The decision issued under this paragraph shall be the first act in administrative proceedings in accordance with Section 68(3) of the Act.
- (4) Additional details on the procedure for determining tuition fees and payment methods are specified in legal regulations, Article 25 of the Statute of CULS, and the internal regulation of CULS on the determination of fees related to studies and administrative-service fees issued by the Rector.

¹ Applicants from EU Member States are considered applicants holding citizenship of one of the EU Member States.



Article 3 Final Provisions

- (1) This directive was discussed at the Rector's Collegium of CULS on June 3, 2024.
- (2) This directive becomes valid and effective on the date of publication on the public section of the CZU website.
